PROVISIONS REGULATING THE FUNCTIONING OF WUST DORMITORIES AND GUEST ROOMS IN CONNECTION WITH COUNTERACTING SARS-CoV-2 SPREAD

- 1. Students and doctoral students accommodated in dormitories as well as individuals staying in guest rooms of Wrocław University of Science and Technology are obliged to comply with the rules of counteracting the spread of infectious diseases.
- 2. In administrative matters relating to student dormitories, please contact the head of the dormitory via electronic means of communication (by phone or e-mail).
- 3. The head of the dormitory, together with the Health and Safety and Fire Protection Department, determines the rules of using public places, such as: bathrooms, kitchens, study rooms, TV rooms and others, including the maximum number of people that can stay in a given room (1 person per 2.5 m²).
- 4. Before checking in, a student / doctoral student is obliged to read the regulations of the dormitory as well as the rules contained in this document.
- 5. People can be accommodated in dormitories and guest rooms of Wrocław University of Science and Technology in single and double rooms.
- 6. Accommodation is possible on the basis of a valid referral or consent of the Vice-Rector for Student Affairs. It is to be carried out in accordance with the procedure specified in the rules of accommodation issued by the Vice-Rector for Student Affairs.
- 7. A total ban on bringing third persons into dormitories and guest rooms under pain of immediate disciplinary eviction is imposed.
- 8. There is an obligation to observe a ban on gathering as well as the principles of social distancing in accordance with the current GIS (Chief Sanitary Inspectorate) guidelines, and to minimize visits to other students / doctoral students accommodated in a given dormitory.
- 9. Students and doctoral students are obliged to frequently ventilate the rooms in which they are staying.
- 10. A maximum of 2 people are allowed to use the elevators in the dormitory at the same time.
- 11. Individuals living on levels 1-4 are required to use the staircase only (except for the disabled people and luggage transport).
- 12. Bilingual (Polish / English) information on the need to strictly observe certain rules will be posted in visible places: the obligation to cover mouth and nose, hand hygiene, cough and sneeze etiquette, avoiding touching your mouth, nose and eyes, the obligation to maintain social distance, the number of people who can stay in public areas at the same time and contact information for sanitary services.
- 13. The obligation to cover your mouth and nose (with masks or face shields) is introduced until further notice for all persons staying in the common parts of dormitories and guest rooms (passageways, bathrooms, kitchens, study rooms, TV rooms, etc.) and while staying in rooms where these people have not been accommodated (visits).
- 14. Only students and guests of the University (accommodated in guest rooms) staying in the rooms assigned to them (excluding visits) are exempt from the obligation to cover their mouth and nose.
- 15. You should equip yourself with protective equipment before checking in.
- 16. There is an obligation to disinfect hands at the entrance to the building and disinfect or wash them before and after each use of the common parts of the infrastructure (toilets, kitchens, study rooms, TV rooms, etc.).
- 17. Dispensers with disinfectant liquid along with bilingual instructions for hand disinfection will be placed in visible places, at the entrance to each building.
- 18. Kitchens should be additionally equipped with antibacterial soap or disinfecting liquid dispensers.

- 19. Administration of dormitories is obliged to organize disinfection of surfaces such as handrails, elevator buttons, etc. at least twice a day.
- 20. In each dormitory, there should be separated and marked rooms with detached access to the sanitary facilities for quarantined people (if possible, at least 5% of the total number of inhabitants). In the case of guests, rooms with sanitary facilities occupied by them become places of quarantine.
- 21. Quarantine rooms should be equipped with additional means for disinfecting hands and surfaces as well as with personal protective equipment (1 mask and a pair of disposable gloves in a separate package).
- 22. In the event of experiencing symptoms suggesting COVID-19 infection, a student / doctoral student / guest accommodated in the guest room should stay in their room, inform the head of the dormitory (via phone or e-mail) and contact the primary care physician by phone. In case of health deterioration, they should call 999 or 112 and let the services know they may be infected with the coronavirus.
- 23. The procedure to be followed in the event of suspected SARS-CoV-2 infection in the premises of WUST dormitories is included in Appendix 2.
- 24. If a resident of a dormitory or guest room is quarantined or isolated, the head of the dormitory or the building administrator is to allow them to stay in a separate quarantine room for the duration of their residence.
- 25. The housing department will provide students with means to self-monitor their body temperature by equipping the dormitory administration with a non-contact thermometer.
- 26. Persons who have left their belongings in the dormitory and would like to cease their residence, should be allowed to collect their property on the terms and within the time agreed with the head of the dormitory or an employee designated by them.
